Tirana Film Institute is an Albanian creative industry whose main focus is based on promoting the creative industry products in Albania and cooperating with European organizations in order to share common audiovisual products such as feature and short fictions, animations, documentaries, experimental, video art and student film in various forms.

Tirana Film Institute carries out its activities in organizing artistic, cultural and cinematographic film weeks, national and international festivals.

TFI is also engaged at all times with film and audiovisual production, design of publicity campaigns, various marketing activities, promotion and film distribution through various shows, screenings and publications. TFI has started a new successful experience as a film distributor getting support from the Media Program of Creative Europe. By combining and exploring new ways of cinematographic work distribution i.e engaging the audience on public debates by screening in various cinema and open air venues including schools and youth centers.

TIFF on Tour acts as ambassador for the submitted films and will travel with a selection to other Albanian cities during the year. TIFF will also propose special screenings to other regional festivals in accordance to a specific subject or theme.

Since 2014 TFI has organized CreativeMornings Tirana, an international project that has ranked Tirana on the map of more than 200 other cities from 67 countries around the world, that organize this event by sharing creative experiences with the community based on a global monthly theme.

This was the change of the very first slogan of TIFF 2003 (*Think Different, Watch Alike*), to the change of its second verb, precisely on the occasion of the 20th anniversary of Tirana International Film Festival.

If once, 20 years ago, when we established this festival together with my colleague Ilir Butka, the very first international festival of any field in Albania, Albanians in general, but also filmmakers in particular, found it impossible to travel to Europe without a visa to follow the latest developments and new cinematographic trends in the world.

And as a matter of course, the verb *WATCH* of the slogan was the original goal of TIFF's establishment, to bring the best and most successful films to the Albanian audience, artistically "usurped" by TV and commercial films. The short film, which was produced everywhere, was almost unknown even to the filmmakers themselves.

TIFF was born 20 years ago and has been the screen where the best cinematographic productions of each year have been shown, after a long and arduous selection work of about 40,000 films that have applied during these years from 120 countries of the world.

If we used to invite the best films, which we had the opportunity to watch at the counterpart festivals, now there are thousands of filmmakers around the world, well-known producers and distributors, who spare no effort to be part of the Official **Selection**.

#### SelectiON...

Since the first day of TIFF's establishment, selection has been the most fascinating, long-lasting and strenuous part at the same time. Thousands of hours staring at the screen to watch every fiction that came to the festival from any corner of the world, but with an inexhaustible excitement and pleasure. I continue to do it with the same passion as on the first day, with the same desire to discover and promote young talents on the long road ahead of them in their career. TIFF is certainly not a large-scale festival from what we are accustomed to often follow in the press and TV chronicles, but precisely for the **SELECTION OF FILMS**, which is the essence of a film festival, it is ranked among the 100 most crucial festivals in the world, certified by AMPAS – Academy of Motion Pictures, Arts and Sciences, Oscars qualifying,

As if this success was not enough, this jubilee year, the European Film Academy also honored us by ranking TIFF among the 29 most important European festivals, to annually propose the Best European Short for the European Film Awards. This is certainly a success for us, but as a matter of fact also a golden opportunity for Albanian filmmakers, here or there across the borders, that through TIFF can be known and become known, for themselves, but also for our country.

# The cinema of AKI KAURISMÄKI





Do you know Finland? Perhaps you are like many who have never travelled to the country in north-eastern Europe: Cinephiles know the Finnish landscape and the streets of Helsinki through Aki Kaurismäki's camera view. It is also thanks to the filmmaker that we imagine the Finns as taciturn people. The German writer Bertolt Brecht, who spent a few months in exile in Finland in 1940, wrote the poem 'Finnish Landscape' in which he discovered "people who are silent in two languages". It should be noted for the sake of understanding that Finnish and Swedish are official national languages. Aki Kaurismäki shows Finnish reality when he makes silence a central theme in his films. The exaggeration or alienation that his aesthetic reveals may also have something to do with Brecht. In an interview a few years ago, the filmmaker said: "I like Brecht's idea that the actor should regard himself as a narrator who only quotes the character he is playing. In this way, audiences are provoked to draw intellectual conclusions instead of just becoming emotionally attached to what they see."

In fact, the silence that often dominates the scene in Kaurismäki's films is most eloquent. A complex world unfolds between the dialogues. With the facial expressions of the actors, their gestures and spatial relationships, the director defines the emotional inner world and social life of his protagonists. The pointed use of artistic means creates ambivalences of expression and a variety of perspectives. Kaurismäki's figures show what people are like: funny and melancholic, desperate and ready to restart – and all at the same moment. You could say his characters aren't thought through to the end because he demands this kind of thinking from the audience. Life in

Kaurismäki's world is therefore never without tension. As in the film noir, to which the director clearly refers, the director counts on the complicity of the audience. Looks, movements and attitudes of the body as well as objects are signs that need to be read.

Aki Kaurismäki's alienated Finland shows human destinies as if under a magnifying glass. The lifeworlds of his films are characterized by alienation – from society, work, family. The filmmaker turns out to be a seismograph of a postmodern world. Social problems and distortions are recognizable, but the focus is always on the people, on the decisions they have to make. Kaurismäki shows us the marginalized, the fallen, migrants. A deeply humane message runs through the Finnish director's films. Even when Kaurismäki leaves Finland and tells stories from France or the USA, he remains true to his point of view. Finland is everywhere.

If one wanted to look for a reason for this film program in Kaurismäki's work, one would find it. In the film "La Vie de Bohème" an Albanian immigrant appears in Paris, the poet Rodolfo. Albania also finds its place in Kaurismäki Land with showing the precarious and vulnerable existence of a migrant. Rodolfo now returns and with him a bevy of wondrous Finnish friends.

She is also Finland's representative in the Strategic Group of Scandinavian Films, an umbrella organization promoting Nordic films, founded in 1978.


### Mauro Mace

## 1ST SCREENPLAY CONTESTIFF 2022

Tirana International Film Festival opened a call for Screenplay Contest for the very first time this year. This call consisted in the application of original live-action and animated short film scripts and other short form scripts of all genres (under 30 pages).

The said competition did not aim to evaluate the best script, but to evaluate from our partner producers and distributors the best and possible script to be produced by them and with the greatest chances to be successfully distributed in the most popular international festivals for short films.

Needles to say, the priority would lie on the scripts whose story was not necessarily and geographically related to the author's birthplace, but which facilitated the production of the film anywhere in Europe and most likely to be shot in Albania as well, thus utilizing local resources, locations and Albanian production companies and Film Commission offices.

The call was opened in October 2021 and closed in May 2022 and by means of Filmfreeway platform we managed to have 85 scripts from 23 countries all around the world to evaluate.

Our partners nominated 10 scripts and shall award the scripts with the possibility of signing a production or a distribution contract at TIFF 2022 Awards Ceremony, on September 30, 2022.


